	Current knowledge in practice related to the candidate's teaching responsibilities current clinical practice.	References and curriculum vitae supporting potential for clinical teaching.
Research	Evidence of the ability to evaluate and apply current scholarly contributions related to practice.	Involvement in: Participation in scholarly presentations of clinical work, e.g., presentations at local/regional clinical conferences, case study, and service education.
Service	Evidence of involvement in service activities.	Participant in professional practice.
		Participation in service activities in relating to professional employment and/or professional practice.
